CRITERIA:

1. Available to high school seniors or students who have lived in the State of Delaware for one continuous full year prior to the application deadline of December 1st, 2015.
2. Candidate shall be accepted into or have applied to enroll in an engineering program of a four (4) year, ABET accredited college within the United States of America.
3. Candidate shall be a citizen of the United States of America at the time of application.
4. Candidate must demonstrate academic excellence and involvement in extra-curricular activities either in the community, in school or both.
5. Candidate may demonstrate financial need.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Applicant shall submit a completed application form, including attachments and essay to The ACEC/DE Scholarship Program, P.O. Box 1858, Dover, Delaware 19901-1858 c/o Scholarship Committee Chair by the application deadline of December 1, 2015. Email: Ryan.Flickinger@KCI.com
2. ACEC/DE Scholarship Committee will select, from among qualified applicants, finalists for interviews which will be held in January.
3. The scholarship will be awarded, and the scholarship winner introduced, at The Engineer’s Week Banquet (Week of February 22, 2016).

AWARD:

1. The amount of the award shall be determined annually by the Executive Committee of ACEC/DE. The minimum award shall be \$2,500.
2. The award shall be a one-time presentation.
3. The successful candidate shall be notified by February 1st of the graduation year. Unsuccessful candidates shall not be notified.
4. All applications shall be considered; however, ACEC/DE reserves the right to reject any and all candidates for any reason, and not offer the scholarship award in any given year.
5. Upon acceptance of the award by the successful candidate, the payment will be made to the scholarship winner following documentation of enrollment. The scholarship winner will be required to provide documentation of payment to the university or college for tuition/room/board expenses.
6. All applications will be discarded at the end of the calendar year in which award is given.
